

GNARC – Radio Room Rules

- No food or open drink containers.
 - Water/soda bottles, coffee containers with lids are OK.
- No operating without a certified club operator present.
 - Members with an extra class license can become a CCO after getting checked out on the equipment by a member of the technical committee. Contact W1FSM for details.
 - Licensed hams may use the equipment with a CCO present, and use their own call sign/privileges.
 - Visitors/hams may use the club call sign under supervision of a control operator (a CCO), and follow all FCC rules for club station operation.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO RECONFIGURATION**
 - Do not disconnect any radios/cables/microphones or any other equipment. It has been designed for easy use by all club members.
 - If you feel something must be changed, or repaired, or have a suggestion, fill out a trouble ticket on the web site or call someone on the tech committee before you do any repairs or changes.
 - No equipment is to be installed, removed, or borrowed unless approved by a tech committee member
- Do not share door codes. No exceptions.
- Use the GNARC computers as needed.
 - Use the “GNARC Member” user ID, no password needed.
 - DO NOT install software/plugins/etc. Contact WB2JVB if you need something installed.
 - The computers are on the city network, and are monitored. Do not even THINK of visiting unsavory web sites.
- Please sign in and out.
 - A sign in sheet is on a clipboard on the desk.
- Turn off all radio equipment when leaving
 - Do not turn off computers.
 - Unplug all antennas.
